



PRAYERS FOR MY DAUGHTER

Lord, give my daughter a heart of flesh.

Ezekiel 36:26

Replace her heart of stone with a heart of flesh. Soften her to Your voice. Replace rebellion with repentance and pride with surrender. Let Your Spirit move mightily in her heart.

Father, draw my daughter back to You.

Jeremiah 24:7

Give my daughter a heart to know You—that You are the Lord. Let her return to You with her whole heart, not just in word but in truth.

Hide my daughter under the shadow of Your wings.

Psalms 91:1–2

Even in her wandering, keep her safe. Protect my daughter from harm and deception. Let Your mercy shield her while You prepare her heart for home.

Holy Spirit, convict my daughter of truth.

John 16:8

Open her eyes to see clearly. Show my daughter what's real and what's a lie. Let her feel the weight of truth—not for shame, but for freedom.

Galatians 4:7

Psalms 119:11

Luke 15:20

Matthew 5:6

Stir a craving in her—a hunger for truth, for love, for righteousness.
Let her taste the world's emptiness and long for the fullness You offer.

John 8:32

Break every lie spoken over her. Let truth pierce through confusion.
Let my daughter experience real freedom in Your name.

Romans 5:8

Ephesians 2:10

detours to bring her to destiny.

Isaiah 26:3

Guard my heart from fear. Keep my thoughts anchored in You as I trust You with my daughter.

Give my daughter a teachable spirit.

Proverbs 1:7

Break through the walls of pride. Give her wisdom and a heart that listens—especially to Your voice.

Let mercy meet my daughter every morning.

Lamentations 3:22–23

Your mercies are new each day. Let mercy chase her down—never letting her forget that grace is still available.

Transform my daughter from the inside out.

Romans 12:2

Renew her mind. Transform her thinking. Let her break free from conformity and step into clarity.

Speak life over my daughter's future family.

Psalms 112:1–2

Bless the generations that will come through her. Let her become a man who leads with strength and walks in wisdom.

Remind me that my daughter is engraved on Your hands.

Isaiah 49:16

Psalms 144:7–8

Proverbs 8:13

Ezekiel 34:11–12

You, Sovereign Lord, said You Yourself would search for Your sheep and look after them. Search for my daughter. Look after her. Rescue her from every place he's been scattered on the day of clouds and darkness.

Let my daughter return to You.

Joel 2:12–13

Even now, Lord, call her back. Let my daughter return to You with all her heart, for You are gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, and abounding in love.

Let my daughter love You with her whole being.

Matthew 22:37

May my daughter love You, Lord, with all her heart, all her soul, and all her mind. Shape her affections to reflect Your heart.

Open my daughter's eyes and turn her from darkness to light.

Acts 26:18

Open her eyes, Lord, so she turns from darkness to light, and from the dominion of Satan to God. Let her receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among the sanctified

Let my daughter stand unashamed of the Gospel.

Romans 1:16

May my daughter not be ashamed of the Gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes. Let her know the freedom that comes from Your truth.

Wake my daughter from spiritual sleep.

Romans 13:11–12

2 Corinthians 6:17

Ephesians 1:17

Ephesians 4:17–24
